

Conference message

International Seminar to Celebrate the 40th anniversary of the Pontificate of Saint John Paul II and the Centenary Anniversary of Poland Regaining Independence “The World Climate Policy and the Paris Agreement - Poland’s Contribution to the World – The New Manhattan Project. Solve the problem of forecasting this Planet”.

After hearing of all the presentations, acknowledging the results of studies and visiting the experimental fields in Tuczno forest site (the World Laboratory – Forest for Humanity in Tuczno) the participants of the conference state that:

1. Polish forests can additionally absorb at least 42 mln of carbon dioxide per year.
2. Taking into account that the current price of 1 ton of CO₂ emission (see www.pointcarbon.com) equals to 25 euro then the value of additionally absorbed tons of carbon dioxide from the atmosphere will reach 1 billion 50 mln euro every year. After a thorough analysis it was demonstrated that the costs of absorption of carbon dioxide are 10 times lower.
3. The Polish forests financial surplus may be utilized for regeneration of the forest soil, creation of the new forests and creation of new workplaces in the rural areas. The additional funds may also be used for helping the developing countries including the implementation of the Great Green Wall project in Africa (Senegal).
